After a mooring has been confirmed, the entrepreneur will provide a mooring and storage place for the above mentioned vessel and/or accompanied accessories.

Smelne Holding BV is not liable for any possible damage to the vessel and/or accompanied accessories. The vessel and any accompanied accessories are not/will not be insured against loss and/or damage by the entrepreneur. The client will take out adequate insurance. Inadequate hull insurance is the client's liability.

The General Terms and Conditions ("Algemene Voorwaarden of the Nederlandse Jachtbouw Industrie (NJI)") for agreements on winter storage and/or mooring hire, are applicable to this agreement and can be found in enclosed supplement. The client herewith declares that he will comply with the applicable Harbour and Yard Regulations and Boatyard House Rules (see back side).

The execution of maintenance work requires separate commissioning in writing, using the designated form Maintenance Vessel and the subsequent commission.

With the signing of this agreement the client declares to agree with the above, to have filled in this form truthfully and to have received the terms and conditions "NJI voorwaarden Winter storage- and ligplaatsverhuur".

House rules of Smelne Holding BV and Smelne Yachtcenter BV

The NJI Algemene Voorwaarden are applicable to all activities and/or agreements with Smelne Holding BV and/or Smelne Yachtcenter BV. By signing the winter storage agreement you declare to have been informed of this.

The opening hours of the boatyard are from Monday to Friday from 07:30 to 17:15 h. The storage halls are accessible during these hours. In consultation with us, other agreements can be made.

On the boatyard and the grounds and in the buildings you are to observe the rules of conduct, cleanliness and safety. Do not offend anyone by your behaviour or way of working.

Minimum insurance requirement is third party liability according to article 2 section 1 of the “Algemene Voorwaarden van de Nederlandse Jachtbouw Industrie voor overeenkomsten die betrekking hebben op winter storage and/or ligplaatsverhuur” (General Terms and Conditions concerning winter storage and/or hire of a mooring space).

Waste can be deposited in the appropriate containers. Chemical waste, oil and filters etc. can be disposed of in consultation with the boatyard.

Specifically for winter storage and ‘do-it-yourself’:

The date on which you bring your yacht for winter storage determines to a large extent the sequence in storage, and therefore, the date on which the yacht will be available again in the spring. Early delivery means late collection and vice versa. After launching in the spring, the yachts must be collected within two weeks.

In connection with the risk of theft or losing property, it is advisable to store loose parts such as outboard motors, pick hooks and superfluous bumpers and anchors, etc. inside the yacht or to take them home.

During the storage in the hall(s) it is not permitted to keep gas bottles and loose fuel tanks on board. We can store them properly against a fee.

When you or we are not working on the boat, your yacht may not remain connected to the 220V grid, due to short circuit and fire risk.

The use of heaters, electrical or otherwise, is not permitted.

The power at the sockets in the winter storage halls will be turned off at night.

In the storage area no welding, metal cutting, grinding or sanding activities are allowed due to fire hazard or dust. Exceptions are to be determined by Smelne at its sole discretion.

You are obliged to collect and dispose of the waste created by working on your boat. When this is not complied with, the boatyard will charge you for the removal cost.
